

LEE COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPT. WILL BE CLOSING A PORTION OF LEE ROAD 236 (AUBURN ROAD) TO THROUGH TRAFFIC DUE TO A BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

ON MONDAY, MARCH 11, 2013, A PORTION OF LEE ROAD 236 (AUBURN ROAD) FROM THE JUNCTION OF LEE ROAD 240 AND LEE ROAD 236 TRAVELING SOUTHEAST TO THE JUNCTION OF LEE ROAD 236 (AUBURN ROAD) AND DOBBS ROAD WILL BE CLOSED APPROXIMATELY SIX (6) MONTHS TO THROUGH TRAFFIC DUE TO A BRIDGE REPLACEMENT.

VEHICLES TRAVELING EAST ON LEE ROAD 240 WILL BE DETOURED AS FOLLOWS: FROM THE JUNCTION OF LEE ROAD 240 AND LEE ROAD 236, TRAVEL NORTHEAST ON LEE ROAD 240 APPROXIMATELY 1.5 MILES TO THE INTERSECTION OF LEE ROAD 240 AND LEE ROAD 430 (OPELIKA ROAD); THENCE TURN RIGHT ONTO LEE ROAD 430 (OPELIKA ROAD) AND TRAVEL SOUTHEAST ON LEE ROAD 430 (OPELIKA ROAD) APPROXIMATELY 1.6 MILES TO THE JUNCTION OF LEE ROAD 430 (OPELIKA ROAD) AND DOBBS ROAD; THENCE TURN RIGHT ONTO DOBBS ROAD AND TRAVEL SOUTH 0.9 MILES TO THE JUNCTION OF LEE ROAD 236 (AUBURN ROAD) AND DOBBS ROAD.

VEHICLES TRAVELING NORTHWEST ON LEE ROAD 236 (AUBURN ROAD) WILL TRAVEL THE DETOUR IN REVERSE ORDER.

CONSTRUCTION SIGNS AND DETOUR SIGNS WILL BE IN PLACE FOR PUBLIC CONVENIENCE.
