**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 02-20
BY THE MAYOR**

I, Gary Fuller, as Mayor of the City of Opelika, by the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions and laws of the State of Alabama and Ordinance No. 008-20 of the Opelika City Council adopted on March 17, 2020, and as otherwise provided by law, hereby authorize, order and direct as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Executive Order No. 02-20 is hereby amended and restated as follows:


Section 1. Except as provided in Section 2 below, effective May 1, 2020, at 7:00 a.m. all City-owned and operated parks located within the City of Opelika shall be open to the public. Anyone using the parks must maintain a consistent six-foot distance between himself or herself and all persons from a different household. For purposes of this Section, the term "Park" means any City-owned and operated areas of land open to the public for outdoor recreation, including walking trails, dog parks, picnic areas, pickleball courts, tennis courts and golf disk courses.

Section 2. Section 2 of Executive Order No. 02-20 is hereby amended and restated as follows:

Section 2. Playgrounds at all parks shall remain closed to the public in accordance with Governor Ivey's "Safer at Home" Order issued on April 28, 2020. Outdoor basketball courts, soccer fields, baseball fields and softball fields will also remain closed to the public to minimize close contact between participants and the shared use of sporting apparatus and equipment.

Section 3. This Order and Amendment shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified by the Mayor.
