**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 01-20
BY THE MAYOR**


I, Gary Fuller, as Mayor of the City of Opelika, by the authority vested in me by the applicable provisions and laws of the State of Alabama and Ordinance No. 008-20 of the Opelika City Council adopted on March 17, 2020, and as otherwise provided by law, hereby authorize, order and direct as follows: Executive Order No. 01-20 is hereby amended and restated as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Executive Order No. 01-20 is hereby amended and restated as follows:

Section 1. Effective May 19, 2020, at 7:00 a.m. all retail and grocery stores in the City of Opelika shall allow no more than 50% of stated fire capacity in the store at a time. To calculate the maximum number of occupants permitted, please multiply the maximum occupancy amount times 0.5. (Note this reduced capacity is approximately 60 square feet per person.) 50% capacity limit does not apply to employees. Require staff to count the number of customers entering and exiting the store and to enforce this as the emergency maximum occupancy.

Section 2. This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified by the Mayor.
