Introduction

The development of the Opelika Bicycle and Pedestrian plan was initiated by the City of Opelika through planning funds awarded by the Alabama Department of Transportation. The plan includes both a long range master plan and a short range implementation plan. The study area primarily includes local roads; however, state and county roads have been included when necessary to provide continuity of accommodations.


The City desires a connected community that provides access for all roadway users and facilitates connection between people and the places they want to be. Currently, the City maintains roughly 216 centerline miles of roadway. Approximately 15% of those roadways contain sidewalk and less than 4% have bicycle facilities. By the year 2030 the City plans to double these percentages by adding thirty-three (33) additional miles of sidewalk and seven and one half (7.5) miles of bicycle facilities. The strategy to achieve this vision includes several goals (listed below and in the presentation):

- Identify the missing connections
- Identify where connectivity can be increased
- Prioritize and phase potential projects
- Identify action items to achieve Bronze Level Bicycle Friendly Community Status
- Identify short term projects


Project Map - Existing Facilities


Project Inset Map - Existing Facilities


Constructability Map




