Vendor Information and Rules

1. Food vendors must have a City of Opelika business license. You can get a one day food license by contacting Lillie Finley at Lfinley@opelika-al.gov.
2. It is free to participate however, we are requesting that all vendors make a donation of 10% of their revenue from the event to the Ambassadors of Change organizations.
3. Event organizers will assign a booth location.
4. Vendors must provide all materials for the booth space, including tables, chairs, equipment, tents and signage.
5. Vendors must provide their own source of electricity.
6. Anyone handling food must wear gloves.
7. Vendors must provide adequate means to maintain food at safe temperatures, which must be 41 Fahrenheit or below; 135 Fahrenheit or above (example: coolers with ice packs and chafing dishes)
8. All food must be prepped under tent (except charcoal and other cooking equipment required by the Fire Inspector to be out from under tent.)
9. Vendors must clean their booths and the surrounding area at the close of the Festival.
10. There can be no disposal of food grease (hot or cold), wastewater, food, or any type of waste material on the streets within the City of Opelika. Vendors will be charged for any damages or trash/refuse left in the area.

I have read all of the above rules and agree to comply with all terms and conditions requested by the event organizers. I agree to assume full responsibility for participating in the event and I agree that the City of Opelika, Opelika City Schools, Opelika Police Department, Lee County EMA, Opelika Fire Department, and their entities, all employees, and all volunteers shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the vendor's property, his/her agents, or any patrons/guests arising from any cause or for any reasons whatsoever in, about, during, and/or because of this event, and I agree to hereby hold harmless any of the above-named entities.
